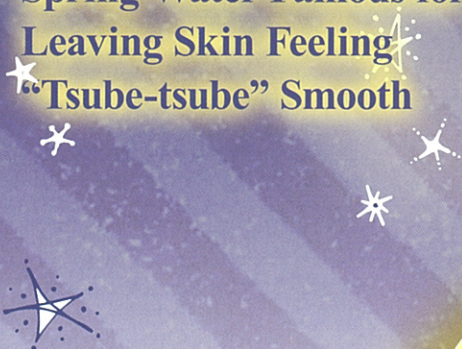

Located at the entrance to the Kurobe Gorge, Unazuki Onsen is the largest hot spring village in Toyama Prefecture, and can accommodate up to 3,500 people. The hot spring was opened in 1923, with hot water flowing from Kuronagi Onsen upstream along the Kurobe River, and has since been appreciated by many writers and artists. It is an alkaline simple hot spring, gentle on the skin. Its clear, colorless water, reminiscent of the crystal-clear stream of the Kurobe River, is said to be the clearest in Japan. With its high temperature at the source, reaching nearly 90°C, it warms the body to the core. The inns and hotels along the Kurobe River provide a panoramic view of the mountains around the gorge that changes from season to season.

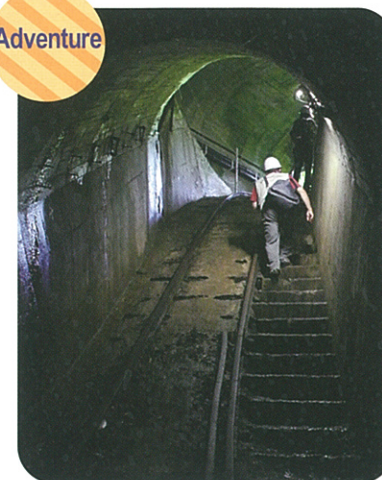
An annual festival held on the first Saturday of February, featuring various fun events like the snow statue contest, torch-bearing skiers descending the slope, and the torch procession.

## Kurobe Gorge Panoramic Viewing Tour on Torokko Train and KEPCO Mineshaft Elevator

A special program where participants can travel on an industrial railway line, including the tunnel and Tateko (Mineshaft) Elevator for a 200-meter height difference, within the Kansai Electric Power Company's facility beyond Keyakidaira station (the last stop of the Kurobe Gorge Torokko railway), which is not ordinarily open to the public. This program also features a strolling route offering an up-close view of the surrounding mountains of the Northern Japanese Alps, including Mt. Shirouma-Yarigatake and Mt. Karamatsudake. Explore the history of electric power resource and the majesty of nature.

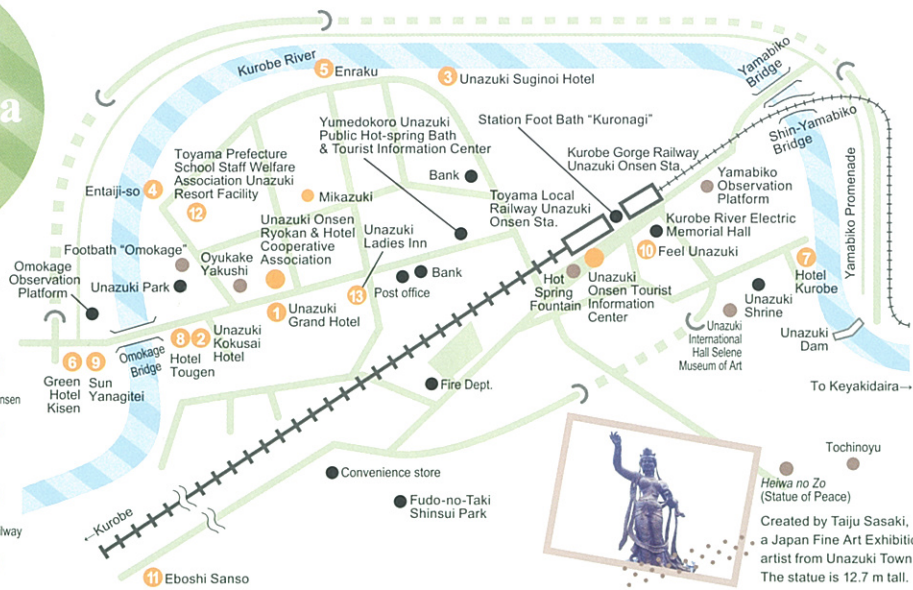

## Heiwa no Zo (Statue of Peace)

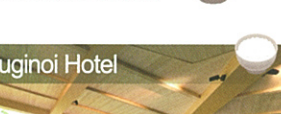
Overlooking the hot spring town from atop a plateau, this is the highest-up bronze Kannon statue in Japan.

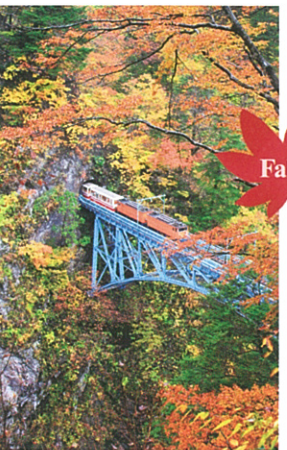


## Kurobe Gorge Railway Mascots

These monkey brothers, three-year-old Kurobei and one-year-old Denchar, have designs based on the Japanese monkeys that live along the railway line, and wear caps and blue uniforms like the train drivers and the station staff. Rumor has it that they live in Sarutobi Gorge ("Jumping Monkey" Gorge) near Keyakidaira, the terminal station of the line.



The little Torokko Electric train winds its way through Japan's deepest V-shaped gorge, running 20.1 km from Unazuki to Keyakidaira via a number of bridges and tunnels, for a short trip through the beauty of the Great Outdoors.

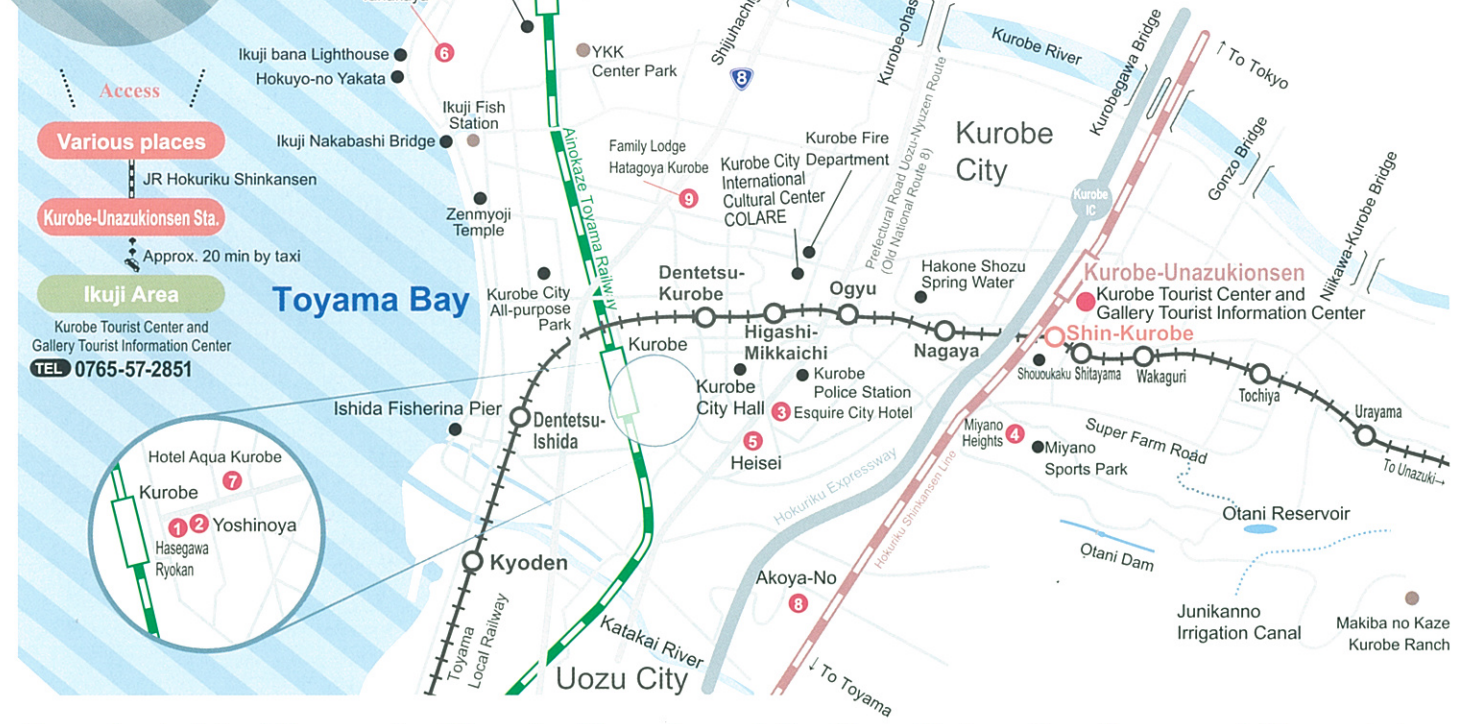

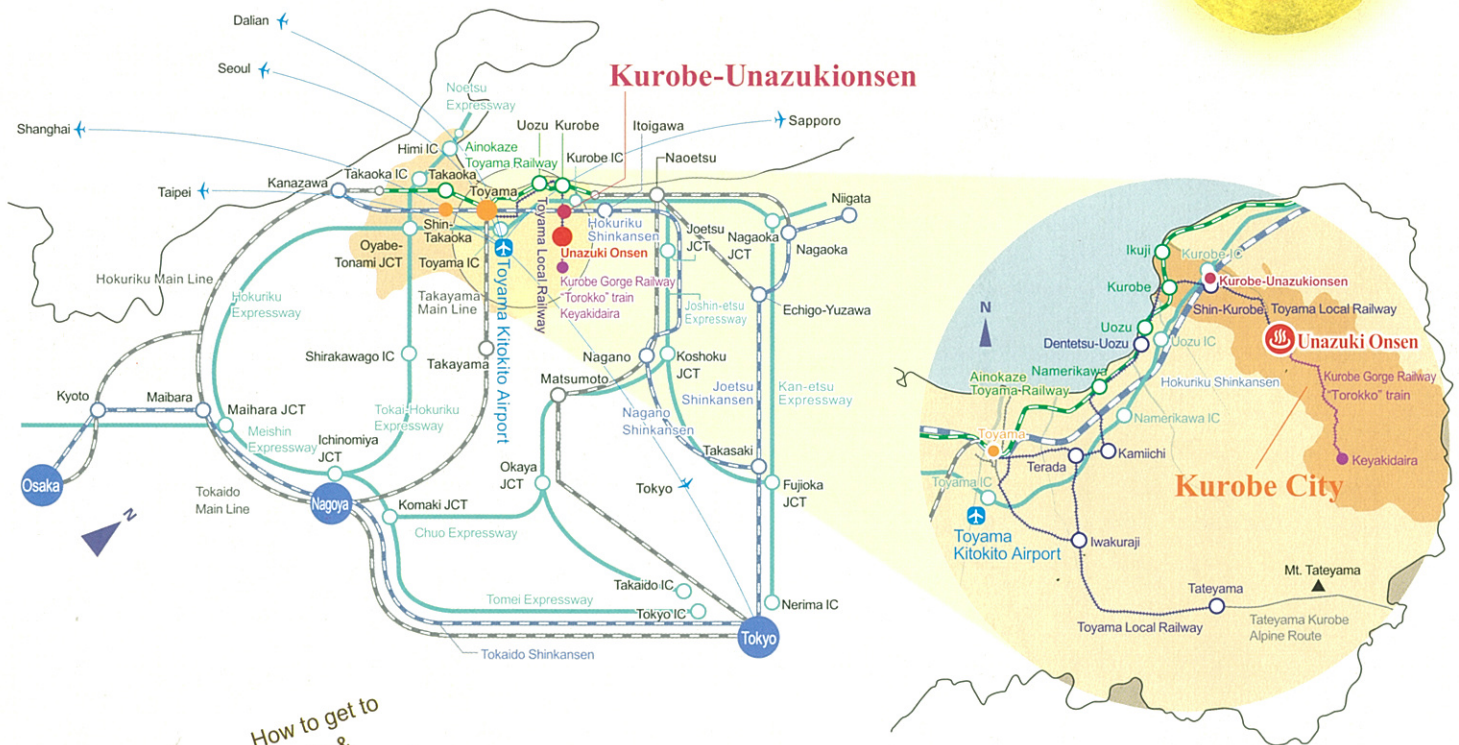
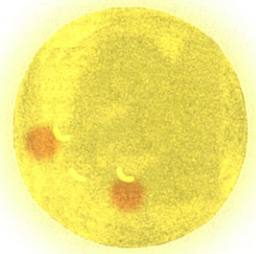
