This hot spring onsen not only makes you feel like the mountains of the Kurobe Gorge are within reach, but also allows you to marvel at the scenic view of the Unazuki Lake from its open-air bath.

Located at the entrance of the Kurobe Gorge, the Unazuki Onsen is the largest hot spring village in the Toyama Prefecture as it can accommodate up to 3,500 people. The hot spring was first opened in 1923, with hot water flowing from Kuronagi Onsen upstream along the Kurobe River, and has since been appreciated by countless writers and artists. It is an alkaline simple hot spring, which makes the water gentle to the skin. Its water—reminiscent of the equally crystalline stream of the Kurobe River—is said to be the clearest in all of Japan. With water temperature at the source approaching 90°, you will definitely be warmed to the core. The inns and hotels along the Kurobe River provide a panoramic view of the mountains around the gorge that changes from season to season.

The fireworks festival decorates the landscape covered with silvery white snow.



Must see!

Unazuki Onsen Snow Carnival

This annual winter festival held on the first Saturday of February features a variety of fun events like a snow statue contest, torch-bearing skiers descending the slope, and a torch procession that anybody can participate in.

Take a Kurobe Gorge Panoramic Viewing Tour on the Torokko Train and KEPCO Mineshaft Elevator!

This special program allows participants to travel on an industrial railway line, including the tunnel and Tateko (Mineshaft) Elevator that reaches a height of 200 meters, within the Kansai Electric Power Company's facility beyond the Keyakidaira Station (the last stop of the Kurobe Gorge Torokko railway), which is not generally open to the public. It also features a strolling route that offers an up-close view of the surrounding mountains of the Northern Japanese Alps, including Mt. Shirouma-Yarigatake and Mt. Karamatsudake. Explore the history of hydropower development along with the majestic views of nature.

Rumor has it that they live in the Sarutobi Gorge ("Jumping Monkey" Gorge) near Keyakidaira, the terminal station of the line.

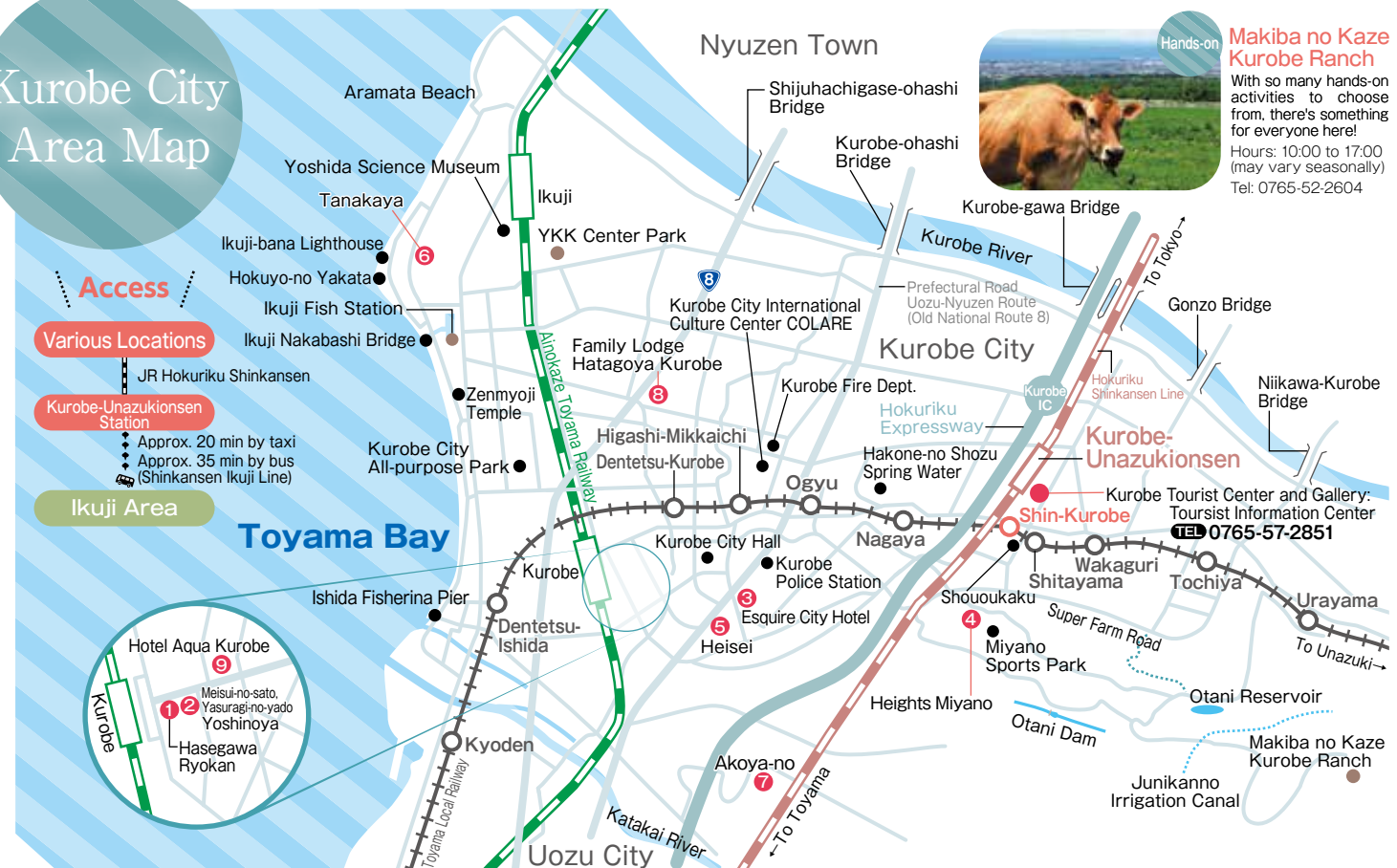
