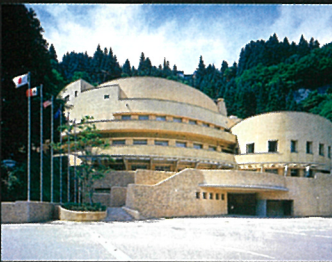

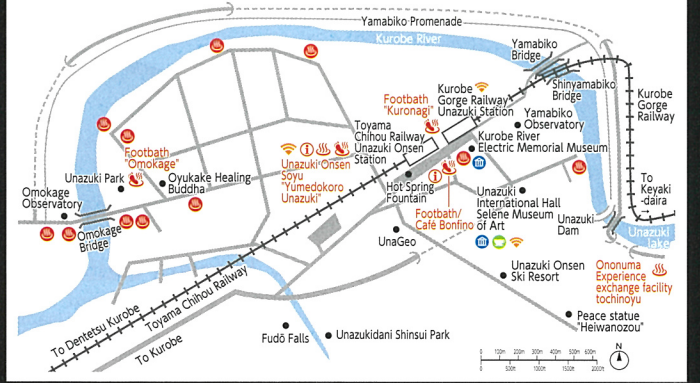
Unazuki Onsen Soyu (public bath) "Yumedokoro Unazuki"

Unazuki Onsen. A day-trip public bath in the center of the Unazuki Onsen town. The first floor has a tourist information center, footbath, and public space; the second and third floors feature the baths, and the fourth floor includes a rooftop terrace. The bath is unique to Unazuki, made of Mikage granite from the local Kurobe River.



The bathwater flows continuously from the hot springs of Unazuki Onsen. The second floor Peach Springs (Momono-yu) and third floor Moonlight Springs (Tukimino-yu) can be enjoyed by all genders at different times of day.


Shō-ōkaku
The garden of Shō-ōkaku, known as the Ginkakuji Temple of Hokuriku, was designed to replicate the Eight Views of Omi. Visitors can make reservations in advance to enjoy matcha green tea in the garden.




Kurobe Unazuki Onsen Station
A JR-West Hokuriku Shinkansen Station, the doorway to eastern Toyama Prefecture. It provides easy access to major tourist destinations in Toyama. The Japan Rail Pass may be used.



Local Tourism Gallery
The facility is located right next to the Hokuriku Shinkansen Kurobe Unazuki Onsen Station and includes a tourist information center and gift shop. It is a popular photography spot as well.



Kurobe Gorge Trolley Journey
If you want to enjoy nature of Kurobe Gorge, ride the trolley to view nature in its pristine state. Gaze down at the clear river water weaving through the rocks. Lean back and relax as you journey deeper through the majestic valley.




Kurobe MAP
